1. Invites the Holy Spirit
2. Sets The Purpose of The Meeting
3. Prepares Our Hearts
4. Prepares For The Work God Will Do

New Study Format

1. Pastor John's Sermon Notes with Reflection Questions
 - The Questions will be Provided for You
 - The Questions will be Discussed with You
2. Optionally,
 - Prepare Your Own
 - If so, All Studies to be Pre-Approved
3. Guest Speaker – Allowed, with Pre-Authorization
 - Not on regular basis
 - Guest Speakers should be a special event
 - Pastor may open it up for the entire body

 - Must Cleaned Up Well

Time Commitment

1. Twice A Month Fellowship Group Meetings: 2nd & 4th Week
 - Choose the Day to Meet
 - Avoid Saturdays
2. Twice A Month Fellowship Group Leader & Director Meetings with Pastors: 1st & 3rd Sunday
 - Sunday After Fellowship Lunch
 - 30-60+ minutes with Pastor John
 - Discipleship Format
 - Pastor John will do his best to raise up leaders.
 - Reflection Questions Discussed
 - One of the sermons will be chosen.
 - Fellowship Group Matters Discussed
 - Also, sharing of the praise reports.
 - Other FH ministry issues may be discussed
 - A Form of Leadership Training
 - If the leader is unable, then send the assistant leader
 - If no one can come, then review off the internet/email – only with a reasonable excuse
 - If no meeting due to holiday, travel, or conditions – get the material off the Internet/email.
3. Rest on the Fifth week, if there is any...
4. Give Priority to Conference days or Special Event days
